- No sunflower seeds on the fairways, carts or greens.
- Allow faster players to play through.
- Play "ready" golf.
- Minimize time looking for golf balls to help keep the pace of play up.
- Please be aware of our groundskeeping staff. They work hard at keeping the course in good shape for you and that means that sometimes they may be working on the fairways or greens when you are about to hit your ball. When they are on the greens, if they don't wave you through, you may have to wait for a minute until they are finished so we ask for your patience. If they are working on the fairway, please use good judgement when hitting up on them. In either case, if you should hit your ball near them, give them a "Fore!" to let them know a ball is headed their way.
- Aggressive behaviour or any form of verbal or physical abuse towards staff will not be tolerated.


