Record Keeping Part 1 - Handicaps



All golfers are encouraged to enter their scores after every game. If you have never entered a score into Golf Canada or did but it was so long ago you have forgotten how, please follow these brief instructions to get you started.

You can post your scores by logging into either the [Golf Canada](#) website or the Golf Canada phone app. If you have forgotten your login information please contact Tressa, our Handicap Coordinator, for your login credentials.

To record a score, click on “Post a Score” which will take you to a login prompt. Entering a score is easy to do and only takes a couple minutes. Be sure to always enter your score Hole-by-Hole, choose the correct course (Regina Beach Golf Club), the number of holes you golfed (9 or 18), and which tees you played from (Forward Red, White, or Blue). Once logged in, you can also edit your Profile information as well as reset your password to whatever you would like. Keeping record of your scores to establish a handicap allows you to see how you have improved as a golfer throughout the season. For brand new users it will take 54 holes for Golf Canada to create your Handicap. Having a handicap also allows organizers to create fair teams when planning tournaments and special games/events.

Record Keeping Part 2 – Sask Provincial Archives
