Lion Jim Sinclair Memorial Forest

The Regina Beach & District Lions Club is pleased to advise you that a tree has been planted in the Lion Jim Sinclair Memorial Forest as a Living Memorial to recognize the Regina Beach Ladies Golf members 2016-2025; tree site #680. The 14th Annual commemoration service will be held to honor all recipients of the trees on **Sundav. September 7th, 2025 at 1:30 PM** and the first Sunday following Labour Day as long as the Forest grows. PLEASE notify other family members of the commemoration date and time so they may also attend.

The RBLGC purchased its first memorial tree in 2015 – tree site #249. The plaque reads “In memory of the RBLGC members from the date of incorporation to

2015.” The formal certificate will remain with the RBLGC Archives. The club plans to purchase a tree every ten years in remembrance of members who are no longer with us.

The trees will be maintained by the Regina Beach & District Lions.

The Lion Jim Sinclair Memorial Forest, located just south of Regina Beach, Saskatchewan on Highway 54 east side of Pappa Geordies Store, was opened in May of 2012 for public admittance. This is project and the groundwork will continue to be ongoing. We hope that you can attend and see as the trees grow and bloom into this living memorial.
